

It was not a coincidence that during Peron's first government (1946-1955) a colossal monument of the "descamisado" (which literally means "with no shirt on" and was the name given by Peronism to the working class members) was intended to be erected on this avenue. During the '70s, with the return of Gral. Perón to Argentina, a plan was made to build a gigantic so called "Altar de la Patria" ("Shrine to the Mother land"), a huge mausoleum to house Eva Perón's remains.


