# Plazoleta Carlos Pellegrini (



This small square seldom visited by tourists, can be considered a replica of a Parisian neighborhood. In its center stands the Monument to President Carlos Pellegrini, one of the most prestigious statesmen in Argentinean history, and it is surrounded by prominent residences made by French architects during the eclectic period. The first rationalist buildings were also built around this square. The plazoleta, an oasis of tranquility and silence, is located in the heart of the city just a few steps from the most important avenue of Buenos Aires, the 9 de Julio Avenue.
